The meeting was called to order by the president, Dave Koennecke, at 7:30 p.m. in the gym of the Sauvie Island School..

In attendance: There were 84 previous members, 26 new members, and 2 guests present. A complete listing of names is included at the end of these minutes.

Dave reported that Dennis Grande passed away earlier today and asked for a few moments of silence out of respect for his memory. Dennis was one of the founding members of this group when it was organized in 1989 as the Sauvie Island Boosters, Inc. and a long-time farmer who operated a farm stand with his wife, Nancy.

Dave welcomed members and guests to the meeting and introduced the current board members.

Minutes: The March minutes were approved as submitted.

Treasurer's Report: Beverley Westlund submitted a report of treasury activity since the last meeting. There is a current balance of \$5771.25 in the checkbook. She reported that website sponsorship renewals have begun to come in.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Willow Elliott reported that plans for the Island Cleanup Day on Saturday, April 24, 2010, are firmed up and include sponsorship by Waste Management, SOLV, Hudson Portable Toilets, and the Sauvie Island Fire Department and ODFW. Other cleanup projects on the island this month include the SOLV and ODFW cleanup on April 17, 2010, of the state lands, parking lots, and some roadway litter; and the Wapato Greenway Weed Pull on April 24, 2010, sponsored by the West Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District. Joe McCray read aloud a resolution regarding anonymous negative e-mails that have been circulating around the island in recent months, and his resolution was met with spontaneous applause. Rob Wiley moved that the resolution be adopted and Beverley Westlund seconded the motion; the Board passed the motion unanimously. The meeting was turned over to the chairman of the Communication and Outreach Committee, Linda Wisner, who introduced our guest speaker, Roger Wendlick. Over several years Mr. Wendlick has compiled what is one of the world's finest private collections of printed materials about the Lewis and Clark Expedition, and he gave a very interesting talk on some of the highlights of his study. He recently sold/donated the collection to Lewis and Clark College, where it is now a permanent part of their library.

Prior to the conclusion of the meeting, Skip White, Nominations chair, announced the results of the election.

§ The bylaws revision was approved by a margin of 78 Yes votes and 25 No votes.

§ Of the four candidates running for three open board positions (Mark Greenfield, Heather Hanselman, Diane Kunkel, and Linda Wisner), the three candidates receiving the most votes were Mark Greenfield, Diane Kunkel, and Linda Wisner. Five individuals received write-in votes, with no single person receiving more than four votes. The voting was overseen and double-checked by Mary Wells, a retired St. Helens school principal and the wife of Columbia County deputy and ODFW Enforcement Officer Larry Weaver.

The meeting was adjourned by the president, Dave Koennecke , and the many volunteers who helped plan, set up, provide refreshments, and clean up were thanked profusely for their efforts.
